**Application:** Write an application letter following the guidelines; attach the essay “Why I Choose to Become a Teacher” and a copy of your high school transcript.

**Deadline:** Return to the counselor **MARCH 29**\_\_\_\_\_

so that it can be returned to Alpha Tau by April 1, the day of selection.  
The counselor will forward the applications to a society member.

# DELTA KAPPA GAMMA SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

## Alpha Tau Chapter

### **The letter of application should contain the following information:**

- 1. Applicant's full name and address.**
- 2. High schools attended with location and period of attendance.**
- 3. Honors and Awards received in High School.**
- 4. Responsibilities held in class or school organizations in which you have participated during high school.**
- 5. Extra-curricular high school activities not included above.**
- 6. Out-of-School activities, offices held, awards, etc. (Community activities such as 4-H, scouts, etc.)**
- 7. Church activities, offices held, awards, etc.**
- 8. Employment experience, if any. Some explanation of financial need should be given.**
- 9. Plans for post high school education or training. Include name of school, location, area you plan to study, your goals and reason for choosing them.**
- 10. Your signature and the date.**
